



EOSS was awarded contract number N00178-09-D-5714 on 19 December 2008. This contract was one of 199 SeaPort-e contracts awarded by Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) on this date. NAVSEA awarded multiple IDIQ contracts for engineering, technical and programmatic services and solutions for the Navy Virtual SYSCOM (VS) Commanders (NAVAIR, NAVSEA, NAVSUP, SSP, NAVFAC and SPAWAR) as well as for MSC, DTRA, Office of Naval Research, Commander Naval Installations (CNI) and the US Marine Corps. This contract vehicle will afford EOSS the opportunity to provide services to a wide array of DOD customers in a competitive and streamlined manner.

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Description - EOSS Quality Assurance Program (QAP)

- The EOSS QAP addresses and provides a description of the organization structure, functional responsibilities, levels of authority, and interfaces for those managing, performing and assessing work. Likewise, the hallmark of the QAP is continuous improvement.
- The EOSS QAP emphasizes senior management's commitment to quality, safety and timely deliverables; additionally, the QAP requires that all work products and each employee of the organization is included within the scope of the quality management system. The EOSS QAP is reviewed by senior management and updated annually. The management processes include planning, scheduling and the definition of how resources are selected and allocated for work.
- The EOSS QAP includes management assessments and independent assessments as defined by laws, regulations and federal directives such as quality assurance program requirements and other structured operational awareness activities; incident/event reporting processes, including occupational injury and illness and operational accident investigations; quality improvement mechanisms such as worker feedback; quality issues management; lessons-learned programs; and performance indicators/measures.
- The EOSS QAP employs a pass-through protocol such that all subcontractors and suppliers to EOSS are bound contractually by the same quality doctrine as EOSS. Likewise, EOSS subcontractor/supplier quality performance is reviewed, analyzed, compiled, documented and made available to stakeholders.
